What is the CPHR designation?

The CPHR designation is a nationally recognized level of achievement within the field of human resources. The CPHR represents 27,000 human resources professionals practicing human resources in Canada, allowing you to expand your network and career opportunities across the country. The CPHR designation gives you credibility and enhances your career opportunities by proving your ability to master all aspects of human resources and demonstrates to employers across Canada that you're an HR expert. By achieving the CPHR Designation, you demonstrate that you are committed to the highest standards of professional practice in HR.

1. Lower Membership Dues

Captus students enrolled in the Human Resources Management Program may purchase a [student membership](#) with CPHR BC & Yukon at a 25% discounted rate of \$45 per year. **Please email support@captus.com and ask for the CPHR BC & Yukon Captus student discount code.** After completion of the program when your membership is up for renewal, you are eligible for a one year New-Graduate Member rate of 50% the General member rate.

A 25% discount is automatically given if you apply within 12 months of finishing the certificate.
